ORDINANCE# 9-10-12 #1

CITY OF ORIENT, FRANKLIN COUNT ILLINOIS AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING HIRING STANDARDS FOR PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS

The Corporate Authorities of the City of Orient, Franklin County, Illinois, herby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. PART -TIME POLICE.

A. Employment, The City of Orient may employ part-time police officers from time to time as they deem necessary.

B. <u>Duties.</u> A part-time police officer shall have all the responsibilities of a full-time officer and such specific duties as delineated in the General Orders of the Orient Police Department, but the number of hours a part-time officer may work within a calendar year is restricted. Part-time police officers shall not be assigned to supervise or direct full-time police officers. Part-time police officers shall be trained in accordance with the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/1 et. Seq.) and the rules and requirements of the ILETSB.

C. <u>HIRING STANDARDS</u>. Any person employed as a part-time police officer must meet the following standards:

- Be of good moral character, of temperate habits, of sound health, and physically and mentally able to perform assigned duties.
- 2. Be at least twenty-one (21) years of age.
- 3. Pass a medical examination
- 4. Possess a high school diploma or GED certificate.
- 5. Possess a valid State of Illinois drivers license
- Possess no felony convictions.
- 7. Any individual who has served in the U.S. Military must have been honorably discharged.

D. <u>Discipline</u>. Part-time officers shall be under the disciplinary jurisdiction of the chief of police. Part-time police officers serve at the discretion of the City authorities, shall not have any property rights in said employment, and may be removed by the City authorities at any time. Part-time police officers shall comply with all applicable rules and General orders issued by the Police Department

SECTION 2. That if any section, paragraph, clause, phrase or part of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance, and the application of these provisions to any person or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.
