## ordinance no. 2-7-06

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS AT THE INTERSECTION OF FRANKLIN AND BUCHANAN STREETS

WHEREAS, the City of Orient, Illinois, is authorized to construct stop signs at the intersection of certain streets owned by the City, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORIENT, FRANKLIN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. There shall be constructed stop signs at the intersection of Franklin and Buchanan Streets, thereby making a four-way stop at said intersection..
- 2. All vehicles approaching the intersection of Franklin and Buchanan Streets shall come to a full stop not less than fifteen feet nor more than twenty feet from said intersection and therefore shall proceed cautiously, yielding the right-of-way to vehicles which are in the intersection or approaching so closely as to constitute an immediate hazard, but then may proceed into said intersection.
- 3. Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a petty offense and shall be subject to a penalty of no more than \$\frac{15}{25}\$.
- 4. All ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage by the City Council as provided by law.
