A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO INSTALL, SERVICE, and MAINTAIN A CLUSTER BOX MAIL AND PARCEL DELIVERY SERVICE ON THE GROUNDS OF ORIENT CITY HALL AS AUTHORIZED BY THE ORIENT CITY COUNCIL ON JULY 1, 2013 IN THE CITY OF ORIENT, FRANKLIN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the citizens of Orient demand and deserve mail delivery to or near their residences as opposed to picking up mail after waiting in lines at the regular business window of the West Frankfort, Illinois Post Office; and

WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service has offered to deliver Orient resident mail to an Orient Cluster Box to be located on Orient City Hall Grounds pending Orient approval; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orient and its citizens understand that the city will keep its zip code of 62874 but all mail will be addressed to street addresses only as there will no longer be any PO Boxes associated with zip code 62874;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF ORIENT COUNCIL that City of Orient will allow the United States Postal Service to install, service and maintain a citywide cluster box for all Orient mail delivery on City Hall grounds at mutually agreeable place on the grounds that will require approximately 20 feet by 10 feet of space.
