## Ordinance Number 9-8-14 A

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF LIQUOR LICENSES IN THE CITY OF ORIENT, ILLINOIS

Be it ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Orient, Franklin County, Illinois

- A. The number of places where alcoholic liquors shall be sold in the City of Orient, Franklin County, Illinois is limited to two.
- B. No license shall hereinafter be issued by the City of Orient, Franklin County, Illinois, to any person or persons to sell alcoholic liquors in Orient at any time after two licenses for such purposes have been issued and are in force.
- C. No license to sell alcoholic liquors shall be issued to any person or persons for any premises located on any part or portion of Orient except the premises located on North Jackson and Lincoln Streets, in the City of Orient, Franklin County, Illinois.
- D. No license to sell liquors shall be issued to any person or persons who are not residents of and residing within the corporate limits of Orient. An exception can be made to a corporation whose owners are not residents of the City of Orient, however, the corporate entity must hire a resident operating manager who actually oversees the day to day operation of the business. Corporations are to list no less than three officers on the license. LLC members are to list their spouse on the license. Background checks will be conducted for all listed on a license application or renewal. Qualifying for a renewal is equivalent to applying for a new license. All individuals listed on a license application or renewal are to be of good character and repute in our community.
- E. Hours of Operation: Except for Christmas Day, December 25<sup>th</sup>, New Year's Eve, Easter Sunday, and the Wednesday before Thanksgiving, the hours of operation are as follows:
  - a. Monday through Wednesday: 7:00 AM until 12:00 midnight
  - b. Thursday, Friday and Saturday: 7:00 AM until 2:00 AM the following day
  - c. Sunday: 7:00 AM until 12:00 midnight
  - d. Wednesday before Thanksgiving and New Year's Eve: 7:00 AM until 2:00 AM the following day
  - e. Christmas Day and Easter Sunday: Closed from 12:00 midnight of the preceeding day until 7:00 AM of the following day
  - f. Premises must be vacated within 30 minutes of closing each day.
  - g. No exceptions are to be made to hours of operation without special permission granted by the Mayor
- F. All alcoholic beverages must be consumed inside the premises. No outside drinking is permitted at any time unless special permission has been granted by the Mayor.
- G. All other, rest and remaining sections, subsection paragraphs and provisions of all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed and

this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of the Illinois Municipal Code.
